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# Lake County Council on Aging hosts free Medicare info sessions

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Each year Medicare beneficiaries have the opportunity to enroll, disenroll or change their Medicare Part D or Medicare Advantage plan.

The Lake County Council on Aging is reminding seniors and other Medicare beneficiaries that the annual Open Enrollment Period has begun and continues through Dec. 7.

Medicare Part D and Medicare Advantage plans change from year to year, so it is recommended that seniors review their coverage annually.

The Council on Aging has arranged for several free Medicare Check-Up presentations to be held in October and November at locations throughout the county. The agency will have trained Ohio Senior Health Insurance Information Program volunteers available to help attendees navigate their Medicare options and assist in making informed choices about which plan is best suited to their needs.
