

Act soon to revise MyCare Ohio plan

The Lake County Council on Aging is reminding individuals enrolled in a MyCare Ohio plan that Aug. 1 is the deadline change the plan.

MyCare Ohio is a new managed care program designed for individuals who receive both Medicaid and Medicare benefits. Also referred to as Ohio's Integrated Care Delivery System, this new system of managed care plans was created to better coordinate the physical, behavioral and long-term care services of individuals 18 and older who are receiving both Medicaid and Medicare benefits.

One-on-one enrollment assistance is available for Lake County residents through the Council on Aging offices at 8520 East Ave. in Mentor.
